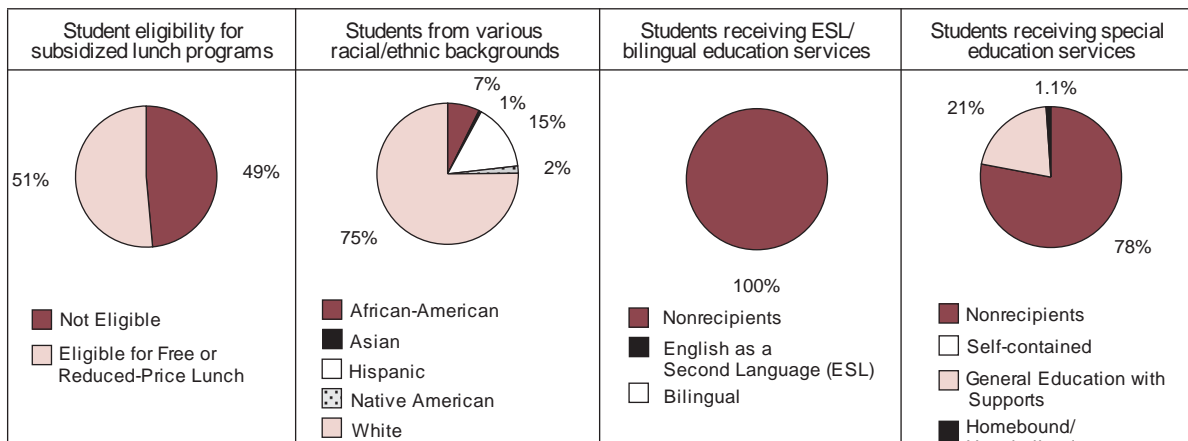

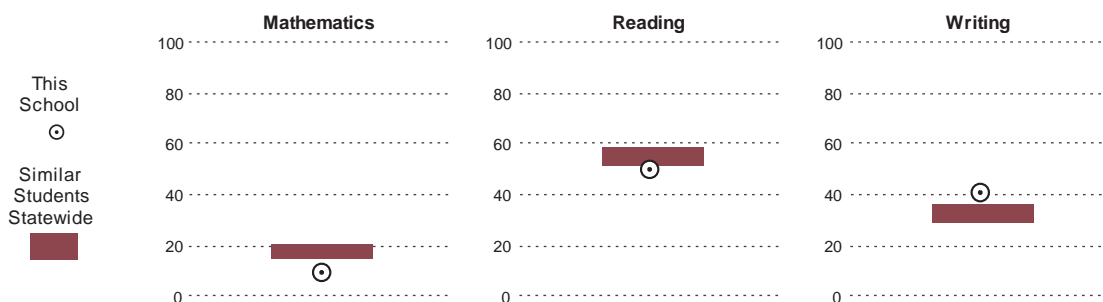

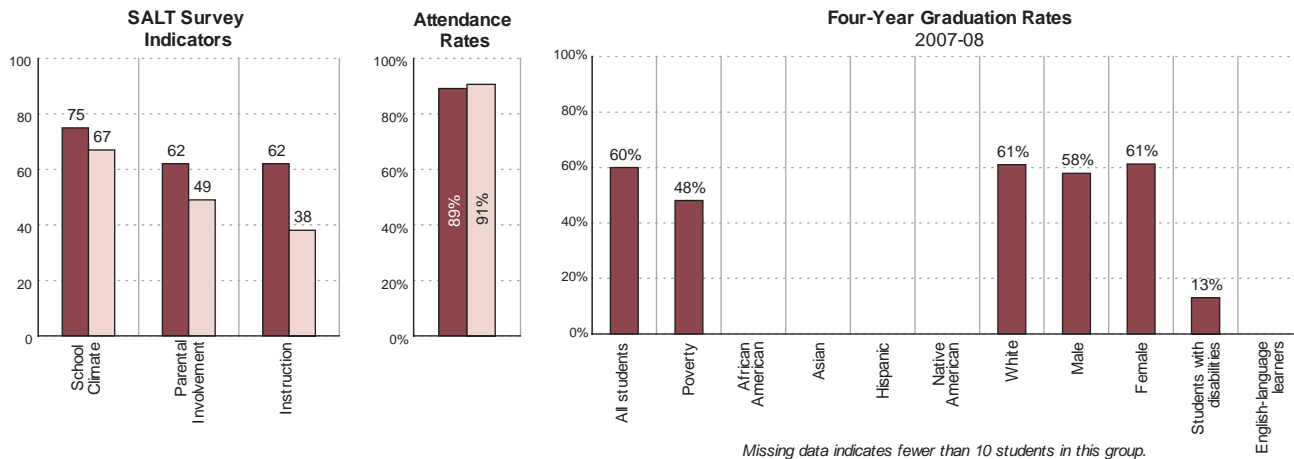
**Percentage of students who reached proficiency compared with the percentage of similar students statewide**
